

1. Purpose of incomplete plans

The purpose of incomplete plans is to monitor the execution and outcome of action plans.

When a learner has been punished or a solution has been tried, the outcome should be recorded using the "Complete Plan" button.

Important information to capture:

- was plan executed by due date
- did the learner's behaviour improve or not
- did the learner's attitude improve or not

Sometimes the plan does not have the desired outcome. When the behaviour pattern is repeated, the second action plan solution should be better or escalated. Something has to change in order to get a better outcome. •4

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
